Profession Is Not Always

Possession

James 2:14-26

In many cases, what <u>Hinders</u> Unbelievers from <u>Coming</u> to Christ is HOW Professing Christians are <u>LIVING OUT</u> their Faith.

LIVING the life of FAITH is perhaps the Christian's Greatest Challenge.

For Faith to be "REAL" it must Be Coupled with Corresponding ACTIONS.

James explains Three Kinds of Faith, ONLY ONE of which is TRUE, Saving Faith.

- 1. SOME PROFESSING CHRISTIANS HAVE <u>DEAD</u> FAITH. (vv.14-17)
- Their <u>WALK</u> does NOT support their <u>TALK</u>.
- As True, Faithful <u>Believers</u>, we have an <u>OBLIGATION</u> to help <u>Meet</u> the <u>Needs</u> of People, no matter who they are. (Matthew 25:34-46)
- It's Faith ALONE that Justifies but Faith that Justifies is NEVER ALONE.
- If there's <u>NO Evidences</u> or <u>Indicators</u>, we can assume there's <u>NO FAITH</u>.
- "Faith without Action is DEAD."

2. SOME PROFESSING CHRISTIANS HAVE <u>DEMONIC</u> FAITH. (vv.18-19)

- Demons Believe in the Existence of God.
- Demons Believe in Godliness of Jesus. (Matthew 8:29)
- Demons Believe in a place of Eternal Punishment. (Luke 8:31)
- Demons Believe AND Tremble with FEAR.
- Being a Christian involves <u>TRUSTING</u> Christ then <u>LIVING</u> for Christ. (2 Cor. 5:15)
- If we Live in SIN, something in our <u>Relationship</u> with Christ AIN'T RIGHT.

3. SOME PROFESSING CHRISTIANS HAVE <u>DYNAMIC</u> FAITH (vv.20-26)

- Dynamic Faith is faith that's REAL, has POWER & Results in Changed Lives.
- Dynamic Faith is BASED on the Word of God. (James 1:18, 21; Romans 10:17)
- Dynamic Faith involves the WHOLE Person.
- Dynamic Faith LEADS to Action.
- Many Believers still Fit the Bill given in <u>Titus 1:16</u>, "They <u>Profess</u> that they <u>Know</u> God, but in Works they Deny Him.
- Belief without Obedience is WORTHLESS.
