We “Deck our Halls” with a variety of Different Things OTHER than Decorations.

MANY “Deck Their Halls” with Loneliness & Sadness or Frustration & Depression.

Let US “Deck Our Halls” with COMPASSION for those who may be Struggling this Christmas...

Today, let’s Reflect on WAYS we can Honor the LORD this Christmas.

1. DECK THE HALLS WITH SINGING.

- If Singing is Something NEW to YOU, that’s OKAY. (vv.1-2a)
- Singing is a way of Praising GOD. (Psalm 95:1-3)
- Praise COMPLETES our Enjoyment. (Psalm 5:11)
- PEOPLE are JUST people. (Psalm 7:17)
- Has the Lord Been GOOD to YOU? (Psalm 13:6)
- Has God ever Lifted your Weakened Spirit? (Psalm 30:11-12)
- Singing is the Most Fitting Thing we can do! (Psalm 33:1)

2. DECK THE HALLS WITH SHARING.

- The Bible Encourages Believers to SHARE.
(Prov. 22:9. Romans 12:13, Hebrews 13:16, 1 Timothy 6:17-19)
- Instead of Wanting MORE, we should SHARE more of what we HAVE!
- This Christmas, let’s FOCUS on HOW we can SHARE More with Others!

3. DECK THE HALLS WITH SERVING.

- Indulging the sinful nature basically Boils Down to being SELFISH. (Galatians 5:13)
- Many people never Think of what they can DO for Others.
- We are Called to be LIKE Christ & Jesus came to SERVE Others. (Matthew 20:26-28)
- Our Compassion for OTHER People ought to be Growing.
- We can ALL Afford to TAKE MORE TIME for OTHERS!
- We must remember People...Jesus Left Heaven for People...for US.
(Galatians 6:10, Matthew 20:28)
