Walking With God Finding Joy In The Journey 1 John 1:3-2:2

Why don't some Christians Experience JOY in their Walk with God?

John says <u>FELLOWSHIP</u> with the <u>Father</u>, His Son, <u>Jesus</u> & other <u>Believers</u> is the <u>SOURCE</u> of our <u>JOY</u>.

Today, John uses the phrase, "<u>IF WE SAY</u>" to point out 3 <u>WAYS</u> that JOY <u>ELUDES</u> the Believer...

1. JOY ELUDES US IF WE SAY SIN HAS NO POWER. (vv.5-7)

- WHAT'S the PROBLEM?
- Some Christians "<u>Claim</u>" to be in <u>Fellowship</u> with God but "<u>Choose</u>" to live in Willful <u>Disobedience</u> to God.
- WHAT'S the SOLUTION?
- CHANGE Our Walk. (v.7a)
- CLEANSE Our Hearts. (v.7b)

2. JOY ELUDES US *IF WE SAY* SIN IS NOT <u>PRESENT</u>. (vv.8-9)

- WHAT'S the PROBLEM?
- We're Given a "NEW nature" but the "OLD (sin) nature" is NOT Taken away. (Gal 5:17)
- WHAT'S the SOLUTION?
- Until <u>WE Call</u> our Behavior what <u>GOD Calls</u> our Behavior, we <u>HAVEN'T Confessed</u>.
- The <u>Solution</u> to <u>our Sinfulness</u> is <u>Confessing</u> <u>our Sin to God & Receiving</u> the Forgiveness Jesus <u>Died</u> to <u>Provide</u>.

3. JOY ELUDES US IF WE SAY WE DON'T PRACTICE SIN. (vv.10-2:2)

- Some Christians <u>Call</u> their Sin by a <u>Different Name</u>.
- WHAT'S the <u>PROBLEM</u>?
- If GOD says we sinned but WE say we haven't, Someone is LYING.

- WHAT'S the SOLUTION? (1 John 2:1-2)
- <u>Jesus</u>, the Righteous <u>DEFENDS</u> the Unrighteous.
- If Jesus already <u>Paid</u> for our sins, <u>WHY</u> do we need to <u>Ask Forgiveness</u>?
- Through the *Finished Work of <u>Jesus</u>*, we enter into a <u>**RELATIONSHIP**</u> with God.
- When we SIN, we Break our FELLOWSHIP with God.
- When we <u>Return</u> & <u>Confess</u>, our <u>Fellowship</u> with God can be <u>Restored</u>.
