Investing The Blessings of God Matthew 25:14-30

The Most <u>PRACTICAL</u> Parable Jesus told may be found on Matthew 25.

This Parable shows us How God <u>TREATS</u> US, How He <u>REACTS</u> to us & How, Often, We <u>MISUSE</u> God's Blessings...

GOD ENTRUSTS HIS WEALTH TO HIS SERVANTS.

- Time, Talents, Treasures, Money, Abilities, Gifts are Synonyms for the same thing.
- This Master Represents GOD, who has Everything.
- <u>WE</u> are the <u>Servants</u> & God Distributes <u>HIS Wealth</u> among <u>US</u>.
- GOD Gives to each of them "According to His Ability." (v.15)

2. GOD WILL CALL HIS SERVANTS TO GIVE AN ACCOUNT.

- To the <u>Five</u> & <u>Two Talent</u> men, the **Master says, "Well Done, Good & Faithful Servant.**You have been **Faithful** over a **Few things. I'll give you MANY."**
- The Master calls the <u>One Talent man</u> a "<u>Wicked</u>, <u>Lazy</u> Servant" & "<u>Worthless</u> Servant."
- Most of us <u>Identify</u> with this <u>One Talent man MORE</u> than the <u>Five</u> or <u>Two Talent men</u>.
- The <u>One</u> Talent man didn't <u>Steal</u> or <u>Embezzle</u> his Master's Talents, He just <u>Didn't INVEST</u>
 it.

3. WHAT WAS THE ONE TALENT MAN'S BIGGEST PROBLEM?

- We have to wonder if he somehow Felt INFERIOR.
- When you're <u>Rubbing</u> Shoulders with <u>Five</u> & <u>Two Talent</u> people, it's <u>Easy to Identify</u> yourself as a <u>One Talent person</u>.
- Jesus tells us this Man was also AFRAID.
- Yes, God has <u>Expectations</u>, No Question, but God is <u>NOT Harsh</u>.
- God's Word <u>Never Commands</u> us to "<u>Be SUCCESSFUL</u>."
- "Be Faithful" & GOD will Provide the Increase.
- You Don't LOSE Talents by <u>Investing</u> them...You <u>LOSE</u> Talents by <u>Burying</u> them!
- Jesus <u>Challenges</u> us to <u>INVEST</u> & <u>REINVEST</u> into the Kingdom of God.
