Knowing God: He Is HOLY Revelation 15:4

If <u>WE</u> are going to truly "KNOW GOD" as we Should, we must <u>Begin</u> by understanding God's <u>HOLINESS</u>.

<u>HOLINESS</u> is <u>MORE</u> than the <u>Presence</u> of Purity & <u>Absence</u> of Evil...HOLINESS Means "<u>SET APART</u>."

Many mighty men of faith <u>Found</u> themselves in the <u>Presence</u> of our Holy God. (MOSES (Exodus 33:18), ISAIAH (Isaiah 6:1-8), PAUL (Acts 9:3-18), JOHN (Rev. 1:17-18))

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE ENCOUNTER OUR HOLY GOD?

1.) WE WILL SEE OURSELVES AS WE REALLY ARE. (Rom. 3:23, Isaiah 64:6)

- The MORE we see of God's Holiness, the MORE we see our OWN UNholiness.
- We Must <u>Understand</u> the <u>BAD</u> news before the <u>GOOD</u> news of the <u>Gospel</u> can make <u>Any Sense</u> to us.
- Holiness is the ONLY Standard for Heaven.

2.) WE WILL UNDERSTAND THE CROSS BETTER. (2 Cor. 5:21)

- WHY did God the Father Kill His Son?
- Jesus came to Provide <u>UNHOLY</u> people ACCESS to a <u>HOLY</u> God.
- The Whole Purpose of the CROSS was to Provide what the Holiness of God Demanded.

3.) WE WILL WORSHIP HIM AS HE DESERVES. (Psalm 30:4, 47:6-8, 99:1, 3, 5)

- There is a **Definite Connection** between **Being Exposed** to **God's Holiness & Worship**.
- When we Understand God's Holiness, Our Whole Life Become an ACT of Worship.

4.) WE WILL CULTIVATE HABITS OF HOLINESS. (1 Peter 1:15-16)

- When we start <u>Recognizing</u> & <u>Appreciating</u> God's holiness, we will be <u>Motivated</u> to <u>Become Holy <u>Ourselves</u>...
 </u>
- We are to "Be Separate" from the World while still "Being an Influence" on it for the Glory of God.

5.) WE WILL BE LIKE HIM. (1 John 3:2)

- The MORE we <u>Learn</u> about God's <u>Holiness</u>, the MORE we <u>Yearn</u> for the Day when <u>SIN</u> will No Longer be a <u>Part</u> of our lives.
- I understand that I will <u>Never</u> be As Holy As Jesus in <u>THIS LIFE</u> but I'm So <u>Thankful</u> for God's <u>Promise</u> in 1 John 3:2...
- In Heaven, <u>SIN</u> will no longer <u>Define</u> who we are...<u>HOLINESS</u> will!
