Living By Faith Not Sight "Taming Temptation" Genesis 39:1-20

Joseph learned that God had a PLAN for his life & That Plan required FAITH on his part.

Has YOUR Life had a Positive Effect on people who Don't Know God?

<u>FIVE PRINCIPLES</u> concerning <u>Temptation</u> that we can <u>DRAW</u> from these <u>Events</u> in Joseph's life.

PRINCIPLE #1: TEMPTATION COMES WHEN YOU LEAST EXPECT IT. (vv.6b-7)

- <u>Beware</u> when you've **experienced a** <u>VICTORY</u> because <u>THAT'S</u> when <u>Temptation</u> often is the <u>Strongest</u>.
- WRONG is Always WRONG No Matter What.
- It's NOT a SIN to BE TEMPTED...The SIN is in YIELDING to temptation.

PRINCIPLE #2: TEMPTATION TRIES TO MAKE SIN LOOK ACCEPTABLE (vv. 8-9)

- We need to <u>Make</u> up our Minds about <u>SIN</u> in <u>Advance</u>.
- Joseph saw <u>Adultery</u> as SIN against <u>GOD</u>.
- SIN is NOT an "Alternative Lifestyle"...it's Rebellion against God!
- Joseph <u>KNEW Sin</u> is primarily an <u>Offense</u> against <u>GOD</u>. (Psalm 51:4)

PRINCIPLE #3: TO BE VICTORIOUS, AVOID AREAS OF TEMPTATION. (vv. 8-12)

- Joseph Refuses her Advances 4 TIMES...
- Eventually <u>Refused</u> to "even be with (AROUND) her."
- Want to <u>AVOID</u> SIN? <u>STAY AWAY</u> from <u>Places</u>, <u>People & Things</u> that <u>ENTICE</u> <u>YOU</u> to SIN!

PRINCIPLE #4: TO BE VICTORIOUS, PHYSICALLY LEAVE. (vv.11-12)

- If Joseph was <u>Going</u> to <u>RESIST</u> the Sin, he had to <u>Get</u> HIMSELF <u>OUT</u>.
- The **ONLY Godly Course of Action** was to **FLEE from her.** (1 Cor. 6:18, 10:13).
- There is <u>ALWAYS</u> a "<u>WAY OUT</u>" for those who will <u>TAKE IT</u>.
- The Longer we WAIT to say, NO! The HARDER it is to say NO!

PRINCIPLE #5: BEING VICTORIOUS, MAY NOT MAKE YOU POPULAR. (vv.13-20)

- Obedience does not ALWAYS Shield us from PAIN.
- When you're <u>Tempted</u> to <u>DO Wrong</u> this week just <u>REFUSE</u>. (v.8)
- Remember <u>WHO</u> you are & <u>WHOSE</u> you are and just <u>REFUSE</u>.
- Because of <u>PAST Failure</u> we're tempted to <u>Give Up</u> in our efforts to <u>Live a PURE Life</u>.
