## Living By Faith Not Sight "Restoring Broken Trust" Genesis 43:15 - 44:34

TRUST is Hard to Obtain & Easy to Lose.

BROKEN TRUST CAN be Restored but it's NEVER the SAME.

To <u>Trust</u> his brothers again, Joseph needed to <u>Believe</u> TWO THINGS...

- (1) They were Telling him the WHOLE Truth.
- (2) They were TRULY Sorry for what they had done.

A GUILTY Conscience does Tricky Things to our MINDS. (Genesis 43:15-18)

**GUILT** had kept the brothers from **Seeing** God's Hand of **Grace**. (Genesis 43:20-33)

By offering <u>TWO TESTS</u>, Joseph Determines if they've TRULY CHANGED.

## 1. A TEST OF <u>JEALOUSY</u>. (vv.43:34-44:14)

- Now, <u>Benjamin</u> is the <u>Favored Son</u> of Jacob.
- How would they React to <u>Benjamin</u> being <u>Singled Out</u> & Given Favor OVER THEM?
- Joseph <u>Instructs</u> his steward to put his own personal <u>Silver Cup</u> in Benjamin's sack. (vv.44:1-4)
- When the <u>Cup</u> was found in <u>Benjamin's Sack</u>, they were <u>Sick</u> at Heart & <u>Tore</u> their clothes in Sorrow. (vv.10-14)

## 2. A TEST OF <u>SELF-CENTEREDNESS</u>. (vv.44:15-34)

- Every One of the brothers Wished that cup was in his OWN Sack rather than Benjamin's.
- They were ALL Ready to Offer Themselves as Joseph's SLAVES.
- Judah said, "it Wasn't "HE" who was Guilty...it was "WE." (v.16)
- Here <u>Judah</u>, who <u>Convinced</u> his brothers to <u>SELL Joseph</u> into Slavery, NOW <u>Offers</u> HIMSELF to be a SLAVE. (vv.32-33)
- <u>REGRET</u> Alone <u>CANNOT</u> <u>Rebuild</u> TRUST.

## THREE TRUTHS ABOUT TRUST...

- 1. TRUST is PRECIOUS, we must TREASURE It.
- 2. When we BREAK Trust, we must seek to RESTORE It.
- 3. TRUST is not simply GRANTED, we must EARN It.
- GOD has Proven Himself TRUSTWORTHY in EVERY Area of your life.
