The High Cost Of Doing Nothing Matthew 25:14-30

Jesus often <u>Preached</u> using Parables of <u>Earthly</u> Events with <u>Eternal</u> Implications.

Many Christians want to hear, "<u>Well Done</u>, my good and faithful servant. <u>Enter</u> into the JOY of the Lord."

HOW can YOU Make Sure those **Wonderful Words** are in YOUR Future.

1. THREE EXCUSES:

- God has <u>Invested</u> Talents & Abilities in <u>YOU</u>; AND He <u>EXPECTS</u> YOU to USE <u>Them!</u>
- 1. "BUT...God <u>Hasn't</u> given me <u>ANYTHING</u> to DO." (1st Excuse)
- YOU were CREATED, SAVED & GIFTED for Ministry! (Eph. 2:10; 2 Tim. 1:9; 1 Peter 4:10)
- 2. "BUT...I can't do AS MUCH as So-And-So." (2nd Excuse)
- Are YOU <u>Faithful</u> with WHAT God has <u>Entrusted</u> to <u>YOU</u>. (v.15)
- 3. "BUT...God is asking <u>TOO</u> <u>MUCH</u>." (v. 24 & v. 26) (3rd Excuse)
- The servant **Dishonestly Blamed** the Lord. (v.24)

2. THREE EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. Jesus Expects Us To MAKE DISCIPLES. (vv. 20 & 22)
- It's NOT Enough to be 'FAITHFUL...Jesus Expects us to be "FRUITFUL."
- 2. Jesus Expects us to DO what He ASKS.
- To MAKE a Disciple...you've got to BE a Disciple. (vv. 21 & 23)
- 3. Jesus Expects Us to SEIZE Our God-Given Opportunities.
- We need to Be Out There & USING what He's Given US!

3. THREE PROMISES:

- Christ's expectations DON'T come Without Rewards for Obedience!
- 1. The JOY of <u>HEARING</u> Jesus say, "<u>Well Done</u>." (vv. 21, 23)
- 2. The JOY of RULING with Christ. (vv. 21, 23)
- 3. The Invitation of ENTERING Eternally into Christ's JOY. (vv. 21, 23)
- YOU are BLESSED to INVEST...
- Count the Cost & Commit to being ALL God has Created you to be.
