2. DAVID'S <u>PLEA</u> FROM THE VALLEY. (vv.3-4)

- It's VITAL for God's people to Know our Prayers Do NOT GO UNHEARD. (Proverbs 15:24)
- David Knew He **Had An <u>AUDIENCE</u>**. (v.3a, James 4:8, Isaiah 65:24)
- David Knew He Would Receive an ANSWER. (v.3b, Psalm 66:18, John 14:13-14, 1 John 5:14)
- David Acknowledged the ALTERNATIVE. (vv.3c-4, Psalm 37:3-5)

3. DAVID'S <u>PLAN</u> TO GET OUT OF THE VALLEY. (vv.5-6)

- David CHOSE To RELY On God. (v.5a, Matthew 11:28, Mark 11:21-24)
- David CHOSE To REJOICE In God. (vv.5b-6a, Psalm 5:11-12, Luke 10:20)
- David CHOSE To <u>REMEMBER</u> How Good God Had Been. (v.6b, Psalm 4:7)
