If I Could Build A Father... Luke 15:11-24

We have a "Good, Good Father."

<u>WE</u> can go from Condemned, Fatherless, <u>Orphans</u> with NO <u>Hope</u>...TO <u>Adopted</u> children with <u>Nothing</u> to <u>Fear</u>.

If I could build a Father, I'd build one just like GOD!

If I could build a Father I'd build...

1. A FATHER WHO GIVES ME FREE WILL. (vv.11-12)

- Even when our Choices HURT US, the Father I'd build would let me Make Them ANYWAY
- He'd also let me go my <u>OWN WAY</u>. (v.13)
- God <u>Allows Us</u> to make the choice of <u>HIS</u> way OR our <u>OWN</u> way.
- Our GOD is NOT a "Fair-Weather Father."
- The Father I'd build would let me **SUFFER** the **Consequences** for my Choices. (vv. 14-16)

2. A FATHER WHO <u>LOVES ME</u> EVEN THROUGH BAD CHOICES.

- Bad Circumstances <u>Turned</u> the son's heart <u>Back</u> to his Father's house. (vv. 18-20)
- To <u>See</u> the Father, the son had to <u>GET OUT</u> of the pig pen.
- He <u>Chose</u> to be <u>Filled</u> with <u>Repentance</u> & <u>Humility</u> & <u>Go Back</u> to his father.

3. A FATHER WHO IS FORGIVING WHEN I REPENT. (v.20)

- Every day, the father <u>Hoped</u> against all hope he'd see his prodigal son coming home.
- When the father finally saw him, he RAN to FORGIVE his Repentant son.

4. A FATHER WHO GIVES ME GRACE WHEN I DESERVE JUDGMENT (vv.21-24)

- The father I'd build would always be Focused on where I AM.
- Our Father's Primary Concern is Always "How CLOSE are WE to Him?"
- "Are you in the <u>Family?</u> ... Have you been <u>Born Again?</u>" (John 3:18)
- Where do you STAND?
- TO <u>THANK</u> your Good, Good Father <u>Sufficiently</u>, all you must do is <u>Receive</u> the Gift of salvation which He has <u>Provided</u>.
