Phraseology is the WORDS You Use & HOW You Use Them...

You demonstrate Wisdom when you Think before you Speak.

The Bible gives great **Guidance** when it comes to Regulating our **Phraseology**.

- 1. CONTROL YOUR TONGUE (James 3:5-10)
- We often <u>Excuse</u> the <u>Sins of Speech</u>.
- Someone who has <u>NO Control</u> over his or her <u>Tongue</u> is usually <u>OUT</u> of Control in <u>OTHER Areas too</u>.
- Scripture advises us to <u>Submit</u> our Tongues to the <u>Control</u> of the Holy Spirit.
- 2. <u>REFRAIN</u> FROM IDLE TALK (Matthew 12:35-37)

T...Is it True?

H...Is it Helpful?

I...Is it Inspiring?

N...Is it *Necessary*?

K...Is it Kind?

- 3. <u>KEEP YOUR CONVERSATIONS GRACIOUS (Colossians 4:6)</u>
- What's the MOST <u>Gracious</u> <u>Thing</u> you can do with your <u>WORDS</u>?
- 1.) TELL The Good News.
- 2.) BE WISE When Sharing Your Faith.
- 3.) Let Your Conversations Be COURTEOUS & SENSIBLE.
- 4. <u>NEVER</u> USE VULGAR SPEECH (Psalm 34:12-14)
- One thing that **CHANGES** when we **Come to Christ** is the **WAY we TALK.** (Prov. 8:13)
- Don't Dismiss the Destructiveness & Seriousness of SIN.
- When Jesus cleansed me of Sins, He also cleansed me of Vulgar Language.
- 5. THINK OF WAYS TO ENCOURAGE, PRAISE & BUILD UP OTHERS.
- Do your **Words** leave a **Positive** <u>Impression</u> on those to <u>Whom</u> you **Speak?** (1Thess 5:11)
- 1.) Don't Use BAD Language.
- 2.) LISTEN Before You Speak
- 3.) HONOR Christ In What You Say.
