

Is God Faithful To Provide?

Philippians 4:10-20

As Christians, we often have Needs that have NOT been MET YET...

We get Confused & Wonder, “WHY hasn’t the Lord answered my prayer?”

To gain Understanding of this problem, we must First ASK this question:

1. DO YOU REALLY EXPECT GOD TO PROVIDE YOUR NEEDS?

- God FILLED some needs of the Apostle Paul in UNEXPECTED ways.
- MATERIAL NEEDS (Philippians 4:10-13)
- PHYSICAL NEEDS (2 Corinthians 12:7-10)
- EMOTIONAL NEEDS (2 Corinthians 1:8-10)
- RELATIONAL NEEDS (2 Timothy 4:9-18)

2. MISTAKES WE MAKE ABOUT GOD’S PROVISION.

- Sometimes we don’t Distinguish between NEEDS & DESIRES.
- What Stresses us out is when we EXPECT God to Supply things He says we REALLY Don’t Need.
- Sometimes we’re Guilty of SCRIPTURE PLUCKING.
- God’s Promises come AS A RESULT of our Faithful & Obedient Relationship with Christ.

3. CONDITIONS FOR GOD’S PROVISION.

- OBEY. (Psalm 84:11)
- ASK. (Philippians 4:6-7)
- BELIEVE. (Matthew 21:22, James 4:3, 1 John 5:14-15)
- PARTICIPATE.
- WAIT. (Isaiah 64:4)
- ACCEPT. (Isaiah 55:8-9)
- PRIORITIZE. (Matthew 6:33)
