## A Solid Promise For A Weary Heart

## Romans 8:28

Some of our <u>Problems</u> are <u>MINOR</u> & some are <u>MAJOR</u>.

If you're <u>Saved</u>, you can <u>Know</u> there's ALWAYS a <u>Plan</u>, a <u>Purpose</u>, a <u>Reason</u> & God is still <u>IN Control</u> of your Problems.

There are Several Things You need to know about the Promise of Romans 8:28.

- 1. THIS IS A VERY <u>SURE</u> PROMISE. ("And we know...")
- There are <u>THREE WAYS</u> you can <u>KNOW</u> this promise is <u>TRUÉ</u>...
- We can KNOW this promise is TRUE by EXAMINATION.
- We can KNOW this promise is TRUE by EXAMPLE. (Genesis 45:1-8; 50:20)
- We can KNOW this promise is TRUE by EXPERIENCE.
- 2. THIS IS A VERY SWEEPING PROMISE. ("ALL things...")
- Could it be that "All Things" <u>Includes</u> the <u>BAD</u> things?
- God CHOSE the <u>Strongest</u> possible word for 'ALL'...NO <u>EXCEPTIONS</u>.
- This verse does <u>NOT say</u> that All Things <u>ARE GOOD</u>.
- God is the *Master* of *Turning Tragedy into Triumph*.
- 3. THIS IS A VERY <u>SELECTIVE</u> PROMISE. ("to those who love God.")
- This Promise is SOLELY for God's Children.
- For the LOST, Good CAN BE Bad, but for the SAVED, the Bad is always made into Good!
- WHAT is **God's Purpose** for **US**? (Isaiah 43:7)
- Nothing <u>Glorifies</u> God more than <u>Recognizing</u> His hand in <u>Everything</u> & <u>Deciding</u> to <u>Trust</u> Him through it <u>Anyway</u>.
- <u>Problems</u> Arise...<u>Tragedy</u> Occurs...<u>Pain</u> is Experienced but the <u>Child</u> of God is Assured that ALL will Work Together for GOOD.
